Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ) January 2022

Happy 2022 Williamsport Area!

Teeball, Baseball, and Softball online registration is open now! <u>Available Programs (bluesombrero.com)</u>

On Wednesday Jan 5th we are starting WALL's Weekly Workouts at Liberty Arena from 6p-8p. Any player that is already registered for 2022 is welcome to come with an adult to utilize batting practice in the cages for free!

If you have not registered online yet, we will be set up and available to accept your player's registration before they join the WALL workout on 1/5.

Below we have addressed some frequently asked questions about our 2022 season. Please review and don't hesitate to ask for any further clarification.

1. When does registration open? Online registration opened August 2021

2. When does registration end? February 20th 2022

3. Will my player have to tryout? *No, all players will make a team. Certain players will need to attend the Skills Evaluation scheduled for February 27th 2022 at the Liberty Arena*

Teeball players are not required to attend Skills Evaluation

Any player that is new to WALL will need to attend.

Any player that is moving up a division will need to attend.

4. When does the little league season start and end? *Opening day is April 23 2022*. *Practices will begin in April and the season runs until early June.*

5. How much is registration?

\$70 per Softball player

\$70 per Baseball player

\$40 per Teeball player

There is a family discount: \$10 for first sibling, \$20 for second sibling, and \$30 for third sibling.

6. What if I need assistance with registration fees? *T-Mobile Little League Call Up Grant Program offers assistance for qualifying families. Please visit: <u>https://www.littleleague.org/call-up-grant-program/</u> to apply. You can also contact WALL for possible scholarship opportunities available.*

7. What is included with registration fee? Team jersey and hat

8. What is needed to play? *Bat, Glove, Helmet, Cleats, Baseball Pants and Socks. Please contact the league if you need assistance with a bat or glove.*

9. How often will my player have practices or games? Your player's coach will determine a practice schedule coordinated around the game schedule. Expect 1-2 games a week.

10. What divisions are available?

Teeball (Boys & Girls ages 4-6) Baseball Minors (ages 6-10) Baseball Majors (ages 9-12) Baseball Juniors (ages 12-14) – dependent on number of registrants Baseball Seniors (ages 13-16) – dependent on number of registrants Softball Minors (ages 6-10) Softball Majors (ages 9-12) Softball Juniors (ages 12-14) Softball Seniors (ages 13-16) – dependent on number of registrants

11. Will I have to volunteer in the concession stand? *Yes, all divisions (except Teeball) will be required to have a family member take a turn in the concession stand.*

12. Will I have to volunteer or fundraise? *The league is ran by only volunteers. Each team will need a head coach, assistant coach, and team mom. Volunteers for special events, umpiring, concessions, mowing, and field upkeep are always needed and appreciated. The WALL board members have a fundraising committee that organizes online raffles. We just ask you support and/or share the fundraising raffles on Facebook. Donation tickets can be purchased on the website.* ****Once your player is registered, they are able to attend the free WALL Winter Workouts every Wednesday beginning on January 5th 2022 at The Liberty Arena Batting Cages****
